



Dulux Warehouse

As the principal contractor, TPS partnered with Browns Engineering to build a 4200 square meter warehouse in the Dulux Zimbabwe's premise in Southerton, Harare. Despite the inherent complicity in the foundation, the six-month project was completed and turned over to the client on schedule.











Southerton Warehouse

TPS built a 5600 square meter shed at the corner of Plymouth and Hobbs Road. Built on turnkey basis, the project's scope included; Architectural and Engineer's designs, earthworks, foundations, steelworks & roof covering, brick partitioning, electrical works, plumbing works & fire protection, slab & ramps, boundary wall & gates, paving, etc.


